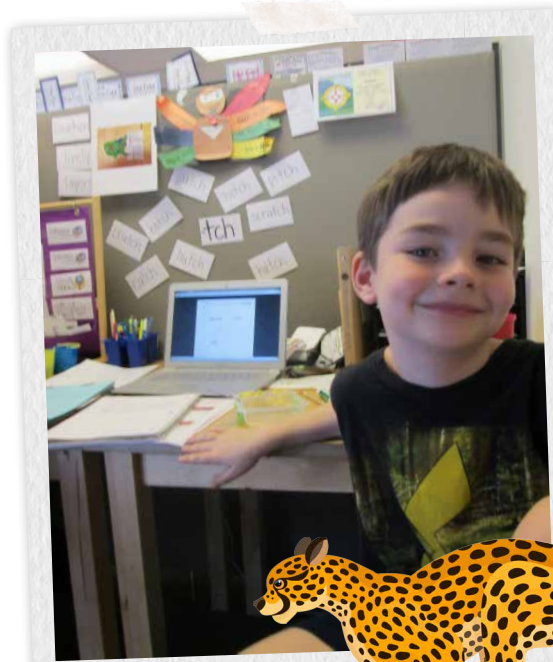
As Dr. Seuss says, "You can find magic wherever you look. Sit back and relax. All you need is a book."

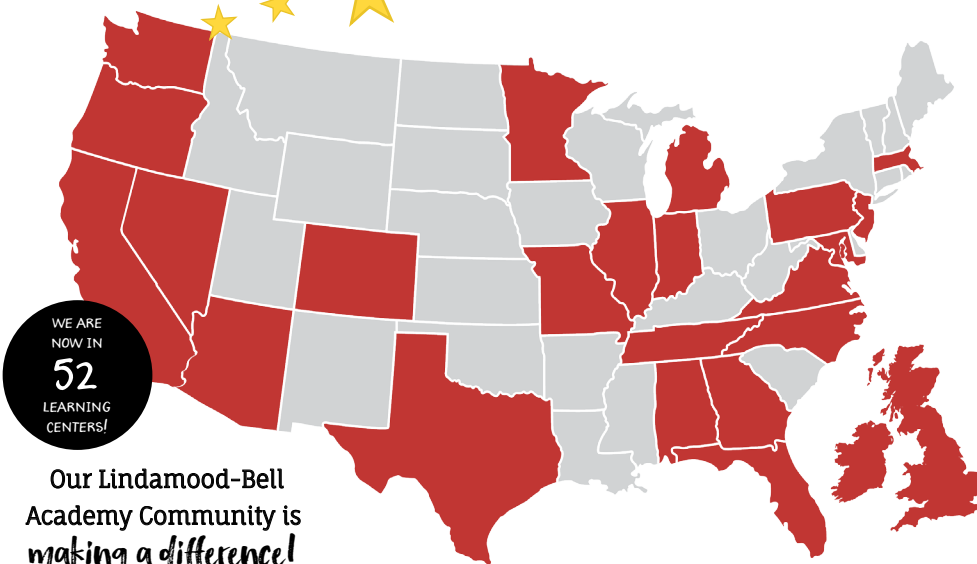
SHINE ON CAST
